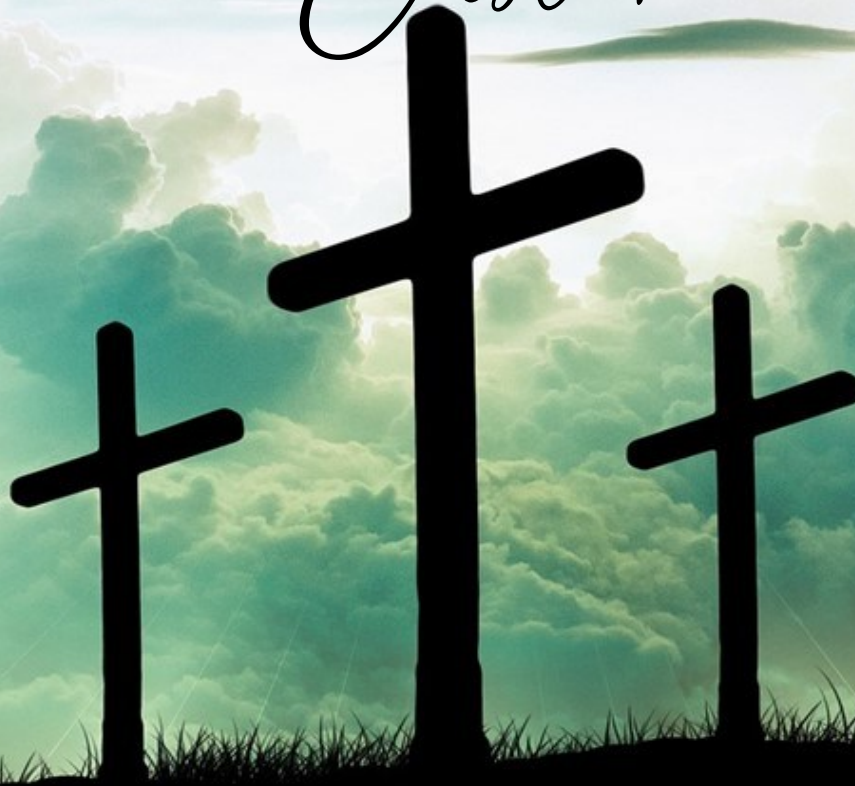

Holy Week & Easter

The summit of the Liturgical Year is the Easter Triduum—from the evening of Holy Thursday to the evening of Easter Sunday. Though chronologically three days, they are liturgically one day unfolding the unity of Christ's Paschal Mystery for us. The single celebration of the Triduum marks the end of the Lenten season and leads to the Mass of the Resurrection of the Lord at the Easter Vigil.

HOLY THURSDAY, APRIL 17, 2025

Mass of the Lord's Supper, 6:30pm

Thursday of Holy Week, the Church begins the sacred Easter Triduum and devotes herself to the remembrance of the Last Supper. At the supper on the night He was betrayed, the Lord Jesus, loving those who were His own in the world even to the end, offered His Body and Blood to the Father under the appearance of bread and wine. He then gave His Body and Blood to the apostles to eat and drink, enjoining the apostles and their successors in the priesthood to offer them in turn.

Veneration of the Blessed Sacrament, 7:45pm

As the Liturgy concludes, we will form a procession to St. Katharine Drexel Chapel to repose the Blessed Sacrament in the Tabernacle. Individuals are welcome for private adoration until 11:00 PM. Because the Eucharist will be in the Tabernacle it is not necessary that anyone stay the entire time.

There will be a special time of remembrance as our High School Youth Ministry will be doing the Living Stations of the Cross.

Solemn Passion and Veneration of the Cross, 6:30pm

The only Liturgy in church today recalls the Passion of Jesus and invites us to come forward and venerate the wood of the Cross, sign of our salvation. We distribute Communion from what remains of Thursday's Liturgy before we depart in silence.

Tonight is the first and most solemn celebration of Easter (lasting about 2 hours) as we light the new fire, listen to our Scriptural story in darkness, celebrate the light of Easter and Baptize and Confirm new members. A reception follows in the Gathering Space.

EASTER EGG HUNT & CELEBRATION SATURDAY, APRIL 19, 10:00 AM

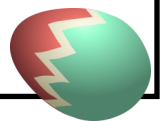
